### Introduction

The Bank had floated the RFP Ref. No. - HO/DIT/HW/MS-Licenses/105 dated 12.07.2018 for Procurement of Microsoft Windows Server Licenses along with CAL.

As per the terms of the RFP, a pre-bid meeting was held on 19<sup>th</sup> July 2018, which was attended by representatives of prospective bidders.

In response to the queries received from prospective bidders during the pre-bid meeting & elsewhere, addendum dated 20.07.2018 containing clarifications to the queries & amendments to the RFP document is issued herewith.

### Amendments in the RFP:
